Day 1

**Venice (Fusina), Italy
Embarks 6pm on May 5**

An independent city-state and major power during the Middle Ages and Renaissance, Venice consists of more than 100 small islands connected by arched bridges and is one of the world's most beautiful cities.

Day 2

Bologna (Ravenna), Italy

Arrives 8am on May 06 | Departs 6pm on May 6

The “Mosaic City” of Ravenna is renowned for its 1,500-year-old churches, decorated with exquisite Byzantine mosaics of brilliant color, and is also a gateway to other spots with claims to historical fame.

Day 3

Ancona, Italy
