According to information received from the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS), you have loans that were discharged due to total and permanent disability. A borrower whose loan(s) are cancelled because of total and permanent disability may later receive federal financial aid funds if he or she meets all other eligibility requirements.

In order to regain eligibility for the federal loan program you must:

- 1) Provide a letter from a legally licensed physician certifying that you are **able to engage in substantial gainful activity**.
- 2) Sign the statement below acknowledging:
 - a. That any new federal student loan(s) cannot be discharged in the future on the basis of any injury or illness present at the time you receive the new loan(s) **and**
 - b. That if any new loan(s) are requested within three years of the date that any previous loan(s) were discharged, you resume payment on the previously discharged loan(s).

I acknowledge that any new federal student loan(s) received hereafter cannot be discharged in the future on the basis of any present impairment unless that condition substantially deteriorates to the extent that the definition of total and permanent disability is again met.
