ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION FOR SUMMER FINANCIAL AID

ENROLLMENT

- You must be enrolled in a degree program at CMU; guest students, non-degree students, and students enrolled in Undergraduate Certificates or Graduate Certificates are not eligible for aid, with the exception of College Teaching, Cybersecurity (Graduate only), ERP in SAP Software, and Logistics Management.
- Only CMU credit hours will be considered in determining eligibility. Students enrolled at a community college or other post-secondary institution are not eligible for summer financial aid through CMU.
- Disbursement (credit to your student account) of Financial Aid is based on your enrollment status; for most financial aid programs you must be enrolled at least half-time (this is at minimum 6 credit hours for undergraduate students and 5 credit hours for graduate students for the semester).
- **Contact the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid (OSFA) before making any changes to your enrollment.**
 - If you drop classes after the disbursement of your aid, it may be subject to revision.
 - Adding a class(es) after your aid has been disbursed means you may need to pay for the class with your Summer financial aid refund.

ELIGIBILITY

- You must be making Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) toward a degree. CMU's SAP policy is available at: https://www.cmich.edu/ess/OSFA/Pages/Satisfactory_Academic_Progress.aspx. Students on SAP Warning during the Spring semester will not be packaged until Spring SAP is determined.
- Pell Grant applicants must have remaining eligibility for the current academic year. Not all Pell eligible students will qualify for a Pell Grant at less than half-time enrollment. Your Pell Grant status will be determined by the OSFA.
- **Direct Loan applicants must have remaining eligibility for the current 2017-2018 academic year.**
- If the OSFA receives information from the federal database indicating that you have exceeded your annual loan limit because of aid received at another institution, you will be required to return all or a portion of the aid received from CMU.

APPLICATION

- To be considered for Summer aid you must have on file the 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and all other requested documents relating to the 2018 Summer Financial Aid Application.
- If you have not previously filed a FAFSA for the current academic year (2017-2018), it must be received by CMU no later than April 1st. Apply online at: www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- PRIORITY PROCESSING is given to students who have filed this form by April 1, 2018.
- **SUMMER APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN JUNE 29, 2018.**
- Be sure your contact information is always up-to-date on Centrallink (<https://centrallink.cmich.edu>). The OSFA sends all communications to your CMICH email account so check it regularly.

PAYMENT DATES – STUDENT ACCOUNT CREDIT (DISBURSEMENT) AND REFUNDS

- Summer financial aid will be credited to your student account (disbursed) when your enrollment is at least half-time and no sooner than 10 days prior to the official start date of the semester or your first summer course (whichever is later).
- Registration of at least half-time is required for payment of federal loans to a student account.
- **Federal loans will be cancelled if you drop below minimum half-time registration/enrollment.**
- The payment of educational expenses (books, supplies, late fees, etc.) is your responsibility pending the disbursement of your federal financial aid.
