Finance Course Offerings:

- FIN 499 is typically spring
- **Major Elective:** ACC 302, ACC 321, FIN 307, FIN 335, or FIN course 400 level or above

### Graduation Requirements

- 120-124 credits—based on bulletin year
- 40 credits at the 300 level or above
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
- 30 credits minimum completed from CMU
- 60 academic credits from an accredited 4-yr institution
- Only 6 credits from PED & RLA count towards graduation

Apply for graduation online at **Degree Progress** two semesters before you plan to graduate using the graduation tab.

**Apply by:** Oct. 1 for May grad.,  
Feb. 1 for Aug. grad., and Apr. 1 for Dec. grad.
