Your Senior Year Protocol can be found below:

1. **Attend the assigned number of cultural events per programming month-** Hispanic Heritage Month, Native American Heritage Month, Black History Month, Asian Pacific American Heritage Month, Martin Luther King, Jr. Week, and Middle Eastern Heritage Week.
2. **Participate in the all scholar fundraiser-** During the Spring semester, MAC scholars will volunteer for one hour.
3. **Attend MAC Scholars Meetings-** During the Fall and Spring semesters, the scholars will meet for a one hour meeting with the scholarship coordinator.
4. **Complete the Cultural and Global Studies Certification-** (if applicable) Together with your advisor, confirm the completion (or near completion) of your CGL Certificate. Your advisor will submit your completed form to the Registrar's office.
5. **Celebratory Registration-** Invite your family and friends to join the graduation celebration, held the night before commencement.
6. **Multicultural Education-** If it has not been completed, scholars should have their final 3 credits from Cultural and Global Studies, International Travel or language course scheduled during this academic year.
