



Sophomore Year Protocol

Congratulations! After much diligence and effort, you have made it to the Sophomore year of your MAC Scholarship. Because of your overall hard work, your MAC Scholarship Protocol has been reduced as you continue to portray the life of a Diversity Champion throughout your second year.

Your Sophomore Year Protocol can be found below:

1. **Lloyd M. Cofer and Multicultural Advancement**- Scholars must earn at least 24 new undergraduate credits per academic year (12 per semester) and maintain a cumulative annual grade point average of 2.5.
2. **Multicultural Award of Distinction**- Scholars must earn at least 30 new undergraduate credits per academic year (15 per semester) and maintain a cumulative annual grade point average of 3.25.
3. **Attend the assigned number of cultural events per programming month**- Hispanic Heritage Month, Native American Heritage Month, Black History Month, Asian Pacific American Heritage Month, Martin Luther King, Jr. Week, and Middle Eastern Heritage Week.
4. **Participate in the all scholar fundraiser**- During the Spring semester, MAC scholars will participate in the yearly fundraising activity.
5. **Attend MAC Scholars Meetings**- During the Fall and Spring semesters, the scholars will meet for a one hour meeting with the scholarship coordinator.
6. **Meet with your scholarship coordinator**- to update your progress towards your multicultural education requirement.
7. **Multicultural Educations**- Scholars are required to complete CGL 145 during this academic year and schedule SOC 302 for their junior year.
