



Break Closure Information

The residence halls in the North (Calkins, Larzelere, Robinson and Trout), South (Beddow, Merrill, Sweeney and Thorpe) and Towers (Campbell, Carey, Cobb and Kessler) communities and CMU Dining Operations close for the three major university breaks – Thanksgiving, winter and spring break periods. The East Community Halls (Celani, Emmons, Fabiano, Herrig, Saxe and Woldt) and University Apartments (Graduate Housing, Kewadin Village and Northwest) remain open during these break periods.

Thanksgiving Break

The residence halls in North, South and Towers communities close promptly at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 24. The residence halls will reopen at noon on Sunday, November 28.

The East Community Halls and University Apartments remain open during the break. The dining units and markets will be closed. Kitchenettes are available throughout the East Community. **You must [sign up through this link](#) by 9 a.m. on Wednesday, November 24, if you plan to be in your East Community Hall or University Apartment at any point over Thanksgiving Break.** This is a safety and security effort and allows us to ensure your ID card has necessary access.

Checkout instructions will be provided to residents in multiple ways including during their November community meeting, in writing on their living unit door/distributed by paraprofessional staff members and informal communication from Residence Hall Directors. Please follow these instructions to check out properly.

Dine & Connect, United Table and The Eatery will all be closed at 3 p.m. on Wednesday, November 24, and will resume normal hours of operation on Monday, November 29.

Central Eats Food Court will close at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 24, and will resume normal hours of operation on Monday, November 29.
