



## Your Preventive Drug Coverage

Your benefits include coverage for preventive prescription drugs with no out-of-pocket payments by you.\* Deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums do not have to be met prior to these drugs being covered at 100 percent. This coverage makes it easy for you to receive medication to help you lead a healthier lifestyle. This benefit includes drugs that help you stop smoking, lose weight, lower your cholesterol, lower your blood pressure and other drugs that address other common conditions.

The standard preventive drug categories include:

- Alcohol dependence
- Cholesterol-lowering agents
- Fluoride preparations
- High blood pressure-lowering agents (Hypertension)
- Prenatal vitamins
- Weight loss

If you wish to use a drug on the preventive list but your prescription coverage has a “closed formulary” or exclusion and the preventive drug isn’t covered, you will have to pay the full price of the drug. Formulary and coverage rules overrule the preventive list.
