Programs in Japan

Japan Center for Michigan Universities, Hikone (Affiliated)

Accommodation: Homestay or residence hall

Language: English and Japanese

Program duration: ~3 - 17 weeks

Good to know: JCMU is located on the shore of Lake Biwa in the city of Hikone in Japan. JCMU programs offer students the opportunity to engage in active learning and participation in Japanese language, culture, and society.

Nara University of Education, Nara (Tuition Exchange)

Accommodation: Residence hall

Language of instruction: Japanese

Program duration: ~17 weeks, Academic Year

Good to know: Study Japanese language and culture and pay CMU tuition! Aside from Japanese language, courses are taught by Japanese faculty in English. No prior knowledge of Japanese language required.

USAC-Kansai Gakuin University

Accommodation: Residence Halls

Language of instruction: English and Japanese

Program duration: ~20 weeks

Good to know: Live in Nishinomiya, between culturally rich Osaka and Kobe in central Japan, near Kyoto and Kobe. Enjoy a relaxing campus setting surrounded by hills, trees, and streams.



Types of Study Abroad Programs

Tuition Exchange

Exchange programs allow students to pay CMU tuition and fees and enroll directly in a partner university abroad. In exchange, CMU hosts the same number of students from our partner universities.

Affiliated Exchange

Enroll through one of our approved affiliates. Some programs are integrated with local students, others are exclusively for international students. Some programs include on-site support services.

Faculty-Led Programs

Study abroad with other CMU students in courses taught by CMU faculty. Most programs run during spring break or summer. CMU tuition and program fees apply.

Internship Opportunities

All internships are credit-bearing and students will work with a study abroad advisor and a faculty advisor to ensure approval. CMU only offers internships through our partner organizations.
