Good To Know: The city of Limerick was founded as a Viking fortress in the 10th century and is now the third largest city in Ireland.

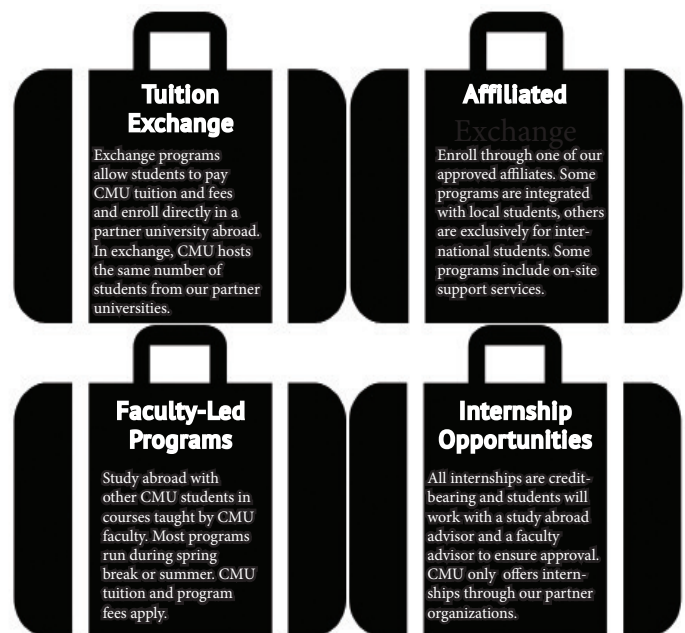
## Italy-American University of Rome (Affiliated)
