

# PRESIDENT'S AND PROVOST'S AWARDS FOR OUTSTANDING RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITY

The **PRESIDENT'S AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITY** recognizes the achievements of senior faculty members. To qualify, one must be a current (not emeritus) tenured faculty member. In selecting recipients for this award, the selection committee will consider the nominees' research and creative activities throughout their careers, with special emphasis on accomplishments while a CMU faculty member. No faculty member can receive this award more than once (a list of previous recipients can be found on the ORGS web site [orgs.cmich.edu](http://orgs.cmich.edu)).

The **PROVOST'S AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITY** recognizes the achievements of less experienced faculty members. To qualify, one must be a current untenured, tenure-track faculty member. Although the nominee's research and creative achievements prior to coming to CMU will be considered in the selection process, emphasis will be placed on accomplishments while a CMU faculty member. No faculty member can receive this award more than once (a list of previous recipients can be found on the ORGS web site [orgs.cmich.edu](http://orgs.cmich.edu)).

Barring exceptional circumstances, there will be two recipients of each award. Each award winner will receive an inscribed award and be added to the list on the permanent plaque in the Park Library.

The selection process begins during fall semester. Nominations are solicited from all sectors of the CMU community. Self-nominations are NOT permitted. Previous nominees will not automatically be considered for the 2020-21 awards. To nominate a faculty member, complete the nomination form and return it to the Office of Research and Graduate Studies, **no later than Friday, September 18, 2020**.

The recipients of the awards will be selected by committee, chaired by the Vice President for Research and Innovation. Committee members represent the FRCE Committee, the Senate Executive Board, and the Vice President for Institutional Diversity. In addition, the Academic Senate elects a representative from each of the seven academic colleges. Members of the selection committee are not eligible for nomination for the awards.
