AN OVERVIEW OF CMU'S ON-CAMPUS ENROLLMENT FALL 2020 Summary

This report contains information about the on-campus enrollment at CMU in fall 2010.

- The official fall headcount is 13,294. This is a decrease of 1,696 (11.3%) students over last fall.
- The number of undergraduates is 11,655 and is down 11.5% from last fall. The number of graduate students is 1,639, a decrease of 183 (10.0%).
- The number of *new* freshmen is 2,057 a decrease of 391 (16.0%) from the previous fall's number.
- The Student Credit Hour (SCH) total for fall 2020 is 177,180, a decrease of 23,247 from the SCH for fall 2019. The average fall SCH per student decreased from 13.37 to 13.33.
- The one-year retention rate of fall 2019 new freshmen was 79.0%.
- The number of new transfer students is 554, a decrease of 141 the previous year.
- 91.2% of first-time freshmen (FTIACs) are from Michigan.
- Minority student enrollment is 20.6% of the student population.
- The number of international students decreased by 168 (28.1%) to 429.
- 58.8% of undergraduates, 55.9% of graduate students, and 63.3% of new freshmen are female.

Enrollment Numbers

ON-CAMPUS STUDENT PROFILE FALL 2020

The number of students registered for on-campus classes this fall is 13,294, a decrease of 1,696 from last fall. The 13,294 on-campus students enrolled for a total of 177,180 SCHs. This is a decrease of 23,247 SCHs for last fall. Of the total SCHs for fall, 152,138 are for undergraduates and 25,042 are for graduate students.

Of the 11,655 undergraduates, 2,370 are freshmen, 2,413 are sophomores, 2,587 are juniors and 4,285 are seniors. There are 406 fewer freshmen enrolled for classes this fall than last fall, 200 fewer sophomores, 401 fewer juniors, and 506 fewer seniors. Over 2,600 undergraduates are attending CMU for the first time. There are 2,057 new freshmen, a decrease of 391 from last year. There are 554 new transfer students, a decrease of 141 from last year. The other new undergraduate students are guests, non-degree students, ELI or International bridge students. Among the graduate students, 1,287 are continuing graduate students while 352 are new graduate students.

Of the undergraduate students, 18.4 percent are enrolled for 16 or more credit hours, 61.8 percent for 12-15 SCH, 16.9 percent for 6-11 SCH, and 2.9 percent are taking 5 or fewer hours. Of the graduate students, 69.1 percent are enrolled for 9 or more credit hours, 19.0 percent for 6-8 SCH, 1.3 percent for 4 or 5 SCH, and 10.6 percent are taking 3 or fewer hours this semester.

Women represent 58.8 percent of undergraduate students, while 55.9 percent of graduate students are women. The average age of undergraduate students is 21 years, while the average age of graduate students is 26.8 years.

This fall the number of minority students on campus is 2,743: 656 Hispanic/Latino, 1,236 Black/African American, 88 American Indian/Alaska Native, 230 Asian, 10 Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander, and 523 two or more races. The percentage of minority students on campus this fall, 20.6, is an increase from last fall's percentage of 19.8. Of the minority students, 2,480 are undergraduates, while 263 are graduate students. There are also 429 international students on campus this fall, a decrease of 168 from last year's total of 597.

CMU has students enrolled from 82 counties in Michigan. The greatest numbers of students come from Oakland County with 1,596, followed by Wayne with 1,175, Macomb with 1,085 and Isabella with 718. The counties with the fewest number of enrolled students are Ontonagon with 1, Luce with 1 and Oscoda with 5. Of those students whose home address is out of Michigan, 436 are students from foreign countries and 1,151 are from other states and territories. This fall we have a total of 49 states and territories represented among on-campus students. The states with the greatest number of on-campus students are Illinois with 466, Indiana with 81 and Ohio with 79. This fall we have 54 countries represented. The greatest numbers of international students are

from China (90), India (58) and Saudi Arabia (56).

Of the undergraduate students, 73.9 percent have a signed major. For seniors, 99.1 percent have signed their major, and 98.8 percent of juniors have. However, only 59.7 percent of sophomores and 15.7 percent of freshmen have signed majors. The most popular signed majors are Psychology (537), Marketing (295), Exercise Science/Kinesiology (288) and Biology (285).

The number of new freshmen, 2,057, is a decrease of 391 from fall of 2019. Of these new freshmen, 170 are from other states and U.S. territories, while 10 are from foreign countries. The greatest numbers of new freshmen come from the following high schools: Mt. Pleasant High School (47), Rockford Senior High School (34), Heritage High School (25), Midland High School (22) and Dakota High School (21). Of the new freshmen, 36.7 percent are male and 63.3 percent are female. Minority students are 20.3 percent of the new freshmen. The average SAT score for entering new freshmen in fall 2020 is 1113. The percent of new freshmen with SAT scores of 1290 and above is 12.3 percent. The average high school GPA of this year's new freshman class is 3.52, higher than the 3.41 GPA from the fall 2019 freshman class.

Of the 554 new transfer students 508 are from Michigan. Among transfer students, 52.3 percent are female, 47.7 percent male; 21.7 percent minority, and 78.3 percent non-minority. The counties with the largest number of transfers to CMU are Macomb (47), Wayne (40), Isabella (36), Midland (35) and Oakland (31).

New Freshmen (FTIACs), Fall 2020

In Fall 1996, Academic Planning & Analysis changed its method of counting new freshmen (FTIACs). For consistency with the U.S. Department of Education's Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) definition, Academic Planning & Analysis now includes students who entered CMU in the summer as well as students who had previously taken courses at CMU while in high school. These students had not been previously counted as new freshmen.

By the older method of counting FTIACs, there were 1,898 first time freshmen at CMU this fall. An additional 159 students were counted as FTIACs due to the change in procedure. On most reports, the Fall 2020 FTIAC number is given as 2,057. However, on some historical reports, to preserve data consistency, the older method resulting in a number of 1,898 has been used.

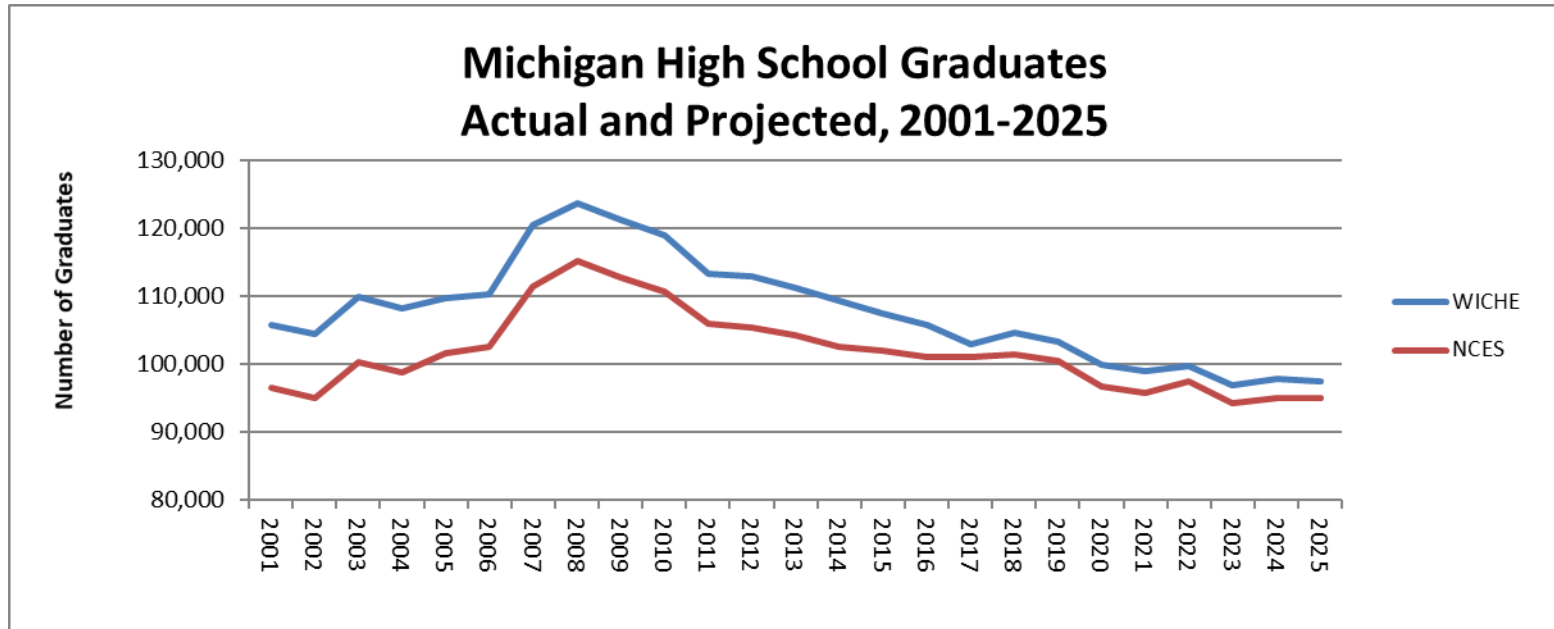
